99 Midnight PDF 3-3, tight game between PSC and Albion in Silver PDF

98 Midnight 2-0, a big battle between Challenge 98 White and PSC in the A bracket of EDDOA

98 Royal 0-8, tough match for the girls that we got to experiment alot in

98 Cobalt 1-1, the girls pick up a strong tie against a fiesty Rush team with some chances to pick up the win--great job

98 Navy 0-2, the girls battled with only 8 players in the match and continue to post strong results

97 Blue 6-2, continue to play well and doing a great job

97 White and Black faced off head to head, and PSC got the victory! This was an exciting match to watch as the girls all played hard, and even had some hard tackles on one another--some great goalkeeping in this one too!

96 Blue 0-3, tough match that saw the girls play strong the first 32 minutes, giving up a goal late, then couldn't regroup-Classic Flight match

95 Blue, 0-2 very exciting game to watch, the girls created lots of opportunities, but could not finish. As a sidenote, 2 years ago they were outscored 16-1 in 2 matches by the team they played this weekend

94 Blue 2-0, great victory in the classic flight that puts the girls at 1-1-1 in league play.

This was a rematch of the game that got them into Division I 2 years prior!

94 White 1-1, game that saw the girls outplay the other side, but just not finish on opportunities, lots of possession from 94 White, some strong efforts.

93 Blue 0-1, hard fought game that just saw the girls come up short

I dont have scores or summary info on 92, 91 or 90 Blue.

As said before, the matches this weekend were exciting, hard fought, and saw the girls have a great deal of fun!

It was exciting to watch the 97 White and Black team square off in EDDOA league play, and to hear the 98 Cobalt girls excitement after their well fought draw!
